5. Declaration of Commitment

I understand and accept that:

1. Course choices are **final and binding** for both years of the cycle (S4 and S5). Changes during the two-year period are **not permitted**.
2. The choice of **Language III (L3)** is binding for years **1 to 5**.

3. The pupil's weekly schedule is derived from the sum of the compulsory core courses, the Mathematics level, and the optional courses. The **minimum** weekly period limit is **31**, while the **maximum** is **35**.
4. Choosing the advanced level of **Mathematics (6 periods)** entails mandatory coverage of **at least 33 periods/week**.
5. Groups for the teaching of elective courses are created **only** if the minimum required number of pupils is met, as defined by the General Rules of the European Schools.
